Dance & Performing Arts Styles & Disciplines Offered at Unit 17

Ballet

Ballet is one of the most beautiful and graceful dance styles. It encourages students to develop skill, control and flexibility. Students will gain precision of movement, strong techniques and a secure posture that will assist with all areas of dance.

Lyrical

Lyrical is a combination of Ballet and Modern Jazz. It takes the grace, poise, elegance and technique of Ballet and links this with steps associated with Modern Jazz to create a performance driven discipline. The music that supports Lyrical helps bring out emotion, fluidity of movements and musicality. A stunning dance style.

Modern Jazz

Modern Jazz has the wonderful ability of being able to adapt and evolve with the changing fashion in dance. In Modern Jazz we aim to make students supple, strong and stylish!

Tap

Tap is one of the most enjoyable and rhythmical forms of dance. At Unit 17 we hope students find this skilful and challenging art form fantastic fun and very rewarding.

Speech and Drama

Speech and Drama at Unit 17 is not only about acting, it is about building confidence. The class also develops team work and cooperation, as well as the dramatic skills of mime, script reading, improvising, directing and an understanding of what it is like to be on the stage. All students will have the opportunity to work towards and be entered for their BTDA Speech and Drama examinations.

Singing

Singing lessons at Unit 17 will help to build vocal technique, understanding and confidence. The students will be taught a variety of styles from pop to musical theatre. Vocal Unit will also teach the important skills such as breathing, microphone technique, the use of movement and emotion to enhance a song and working as a group to sing in perfect harmony. Vocal Unit classes will also take part in a performance each year.

Musical Theatre
